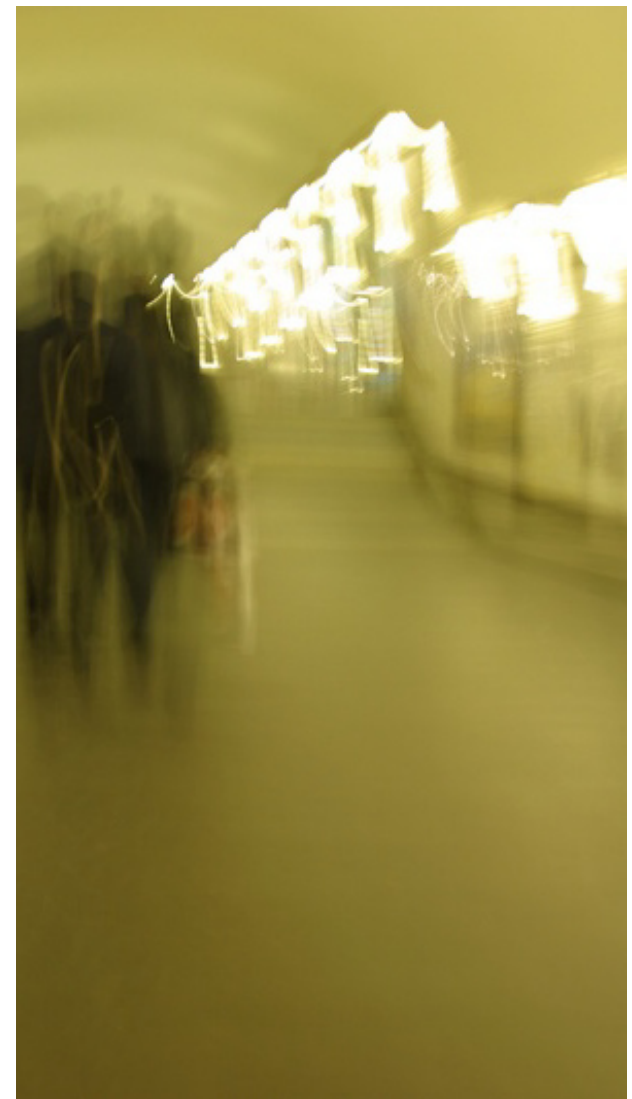

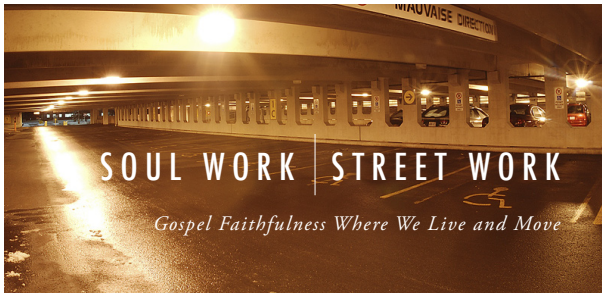

WHY

There is a deep need in Christian communities: the skills and disciplines needed to become communities able to *discern* and *do* the will of God in their time and place. To put it another way, they want to be people who are able to *listen for*, *identify*, and *obey* the direction of God. This retreat is an effort toward that end.

WHAT

The God of all creation is still calling for a people. His kingdom is breaking upon our land and he is looking for a people who will join Him. Are we His people? Are we willing to WORK with him? We need to learn the work of the soul and the street, the inner and outer journeys.

This will be a highly participatory, multi-faceted retreat. Our time will be deeply shaped by each one attending and the various contexts that all represent. We believe in the profound power of kingdom community, and we will experience it together. This is NOT a conference...it will hopefully be a transformational retreat. Mere attendance will not be sufficient, *participation and full presence will be necessary.*

There will be:

- Thought-provoking discussions
- Guided individual & corporate exercises
- Times of silence and reflection
- Collected worship
- Mutual storytelling and testifying
- Biblical engagement

Because we believe that the people of God travel *together* and is really a body that needs one another...Registration must be in groups (at least one other person)...This involves a commitment to discuss a few articles/questions beforehand...attend together, and to be accountable following the event.

This event requires full participation and presence for the entire duration. It begins at 6pm on Friday and will finish promptly by 3pm on Sunday. All meals and lodging will be shared. For the sake of the whole, all attending need to begin and end together. In addition to our shared discussions, storytelling, and small group times, we also will be sharing basic cleanup, and housekeeping duties

In preparation for this time together, we ask that each group of people attending together will (at minimum) read and discuss a few articles together before arriving. There is also an extended reading list and some suggested practices to begin (or continue), which are highly recommended. There will be some among us who will have significant time and experience in some of these things and we will all greatly benefit from each others wisdom.

We also ask that with your registration, each individual would submit 5 digital photos/images that would help us all know where you come from & return to.

WHERE

The retreat is being held at the Lindenwood Retreat & Conference Center in Donaldson, Indiana (www.lindenwood.org).

Lindenwood is located on the shores of Lake Gilbraith in rural Northwest Indiana, 8 miles west of Plymouth and 40 miles south of South Bend, just 2 miles off of Highway 30.
